Hamburger & Potato Casserole

Millar Angus
APPROVED

- 2 lb. ground beef
- 1 medium onion, finely chopped
- 3-4 medium potatoes, thinly sliced (peeled if desired)
- 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese
- 1 can cream of mushroom soup
- Salt & Pepper to taste
- 1/2 cup milk
- 1/2 cup sour cream
- Paprika, optional

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Thinly slice potatoes and set aside. Brown ground beef/onion, drain. Season with salt/pepper. In bowl, mix together soup, milk and sour cream until smooth.

In a greased 9x13 baking dish, layer half the sliced potatoes. Spread half of the cooked ground beef over the potatoes. Pour half of the creamy sauce over the beef and potatoes. Repeat layers with remaining potatoes, beef and sauce. Sprinkle the top with shredded cheese and a dash of paprika.

Cover with aluminum foil and bake for 1 hour. Remove foil and bake an additional 20-30 minutes, until potatoes are tender and top is golden and bubbly.

A little bit about the Dustman Ranch: The Dustman Ranch is owned and operated by Jack and Caleb Dustman along with Caleb's wife, Emily. Jack and Caleb are 4th and 5th generation, respectively. They are a cow calf Angus operation and run on about 4,000 acres near Farmingdale, SD.

Millar Angus genetics on the Dustman Ranch: We like using Millar Angus genetics for several reasons. Their genetics lead to even calves with excellent composition that really shine at sale time. We try to market a versatile set of calves and solid genetics allows us to do that. Disposition is another key factor for us. There are only two of us so having gentle bulls that are easy to handle is

very important. The longevity of these bulls and the future breeding stock they produce is hard to beat. The bulls stay in good condition while breeding and do not seem as prone to foot problems. Calving ease is another important factor for us. We like to see healthy cows and calves that require little intervention. Even though our calves are on the lighter birthweight side they gain quickly thanks to solid breeding stock we have raised from birth. Finally, the Millar Family themselves. This is also very important! There are a lot of options out there and we choose to do business with people who share our values and who have unmatched integrity.
